The DRC reserves the right to not allow any plant material that it deems inappropriate for Blossom Rock or for a particular application.

- Polyethylene film or other plastic barriers under landscape areas.
- Steel, plastic, scalloped concrete or wooden headers or borders in the Front Yard Zone.
- Colored rock, gravels, decomposed granite or mineral ground cover other than those described and specifically allowed by these Guidelines.
